50th ANNUAL MEETING—Jan. 18

In January of 1966, a group of people met to form a new parish from two existing congregations — St. John's Mission (Sawtelle) and the Parish of the Good Shepherd in Ocean Park. On Jan. 18, that parish -St. Bede's-will hold its 50th Annual Meeting in Luther Hall following the 10 a.m. Holy Eucharist and a pot-luck luncheon. This meeting is a time when reports covering the year past are made to the parish, the Vestry reports on the 2015 Budget which was passed by the Vestry in mid-December, and elections are held for open seats on the vestry & for St. Bede's representation to the Convention of the Diocese of Los Angeles.

The Nominating Committee of the Vestry will present a roster of candidates: For Vestry: 4 candidates -2 yr. Terms (Jerry Hornof is leaving the vestry). The Vestry meets monthly on the 4th Monday each month and for a winter planning retreat (in 2015, 2/21). Members serve on at least one of the three main committees: Finance & Facilities, Outreach, & Program.

For Diocesan Convention Delegate and Alternate (2 ea.-2yr. terms): These people represent the parish at the Annual Convention of the Diocese (12/4-5/2015) and at any meetings of the Deanery, as scheduled.
