MOUNTAIN-TOPS

On March 2nd, we will hear about Jesus' mountain-top experience with his inner circle of disciples. Seeing Jesus transfigured (shining) and in the presence of the great heroes of Jewish history, his disciples wanted to build three shrines (or tabernacles) to "save the moment".

It is a fitting way to end the time of Epiphany-tide, the manifestation of Jesus. This event was the manifestation of Jesus' divinity to his disciples. Could they now follow him to Jerusalem? Could they walk a path that would lead Jesus to the cross of Calvary? Can we?

LENT: DEAD AHEAD

Lent begin on March 5 with **ASH WEDNESDAY**. On the day before, we prepare for that by celebrating **SHROVE TUESDAY** with our Lutheran brothers and sisters AT St. Andrew's. We have two services on **ASH WEDNESDAY** (Noon & 7), the earlier being at St. Andrew's. Each Wednesday, we will have a soup supper and Eucharist and Class starting at 6.30 **AT** St. Bede's. This year, we will be studying the **REVELATION TO JOHN** (everyone's favorite). We will have a **LENTEN QUIET DAY** with Br. Tom Carey, SSF on March. 22. We will also have Lenten resources from both the Forward Movement and Episcopal Relief and Development (and don't forget 2014 Lent Madness). **HOLY WEEK** begins with Palm Sunday on April 13 and culminates with the celebration of Easter on April 30 (including 12 services in those 8 days!).
