LENT IS UPON US!

Lent is a season when we find ourselves walking toward Jerusalem with Jesus and his disciples. On Ash Wednesday, we are reminded that we are human and that we all will return to the ground out of which we were created. On Lent 1, we are reminded that, like Jesus, we are also tempted to "...err and stray from [God's] way like lost sheep." On Lent 2, we will again hear Jesus' words to Nicodemus that are called to be "...born from above [or again]" and reminded that God's love in and through Jesus brings us the promise of eternal life.

In Lent, the parament colors change, the service begins differently (with the Great Litany, the Exhortation or the Penitential Office), and the music often takes on a minor key. We also have classes that begin in Lent: our Wednesday evening Bible study [preceded by soup at 6.30 pm] (this year on *The Revelation to John*) and the basic Via Media class on Sundays at Noon. On Sat., March 22, Br. Tom Carey, SSF will be with us for the Lenten Quiet Day.
