STEWARDSHIP

STEWARDSHIP has a goal that each person in the parish prayerfully look at their giving in thanksgiving for what God has given them. The best way to do that is to set a percentage of income to set aside for God's work in the world. We call that a "tithe". That is a Biblical term, sometimes meaning 10% and sometimes another percentage, but it is a percent, not a dollar amount. The stewardship committee included a proportional giving worksheet to help each person with that prayerful planning.

Unlike some religious groups, we do not set a certain fee which must be paid. We believe that if all parishioners seriously consider their relationship with God and their response in time, talent and (yes) treasure, the effect at St. Bede's will be to continue to effect a faithful ministry here in the Mar Vista/Venice community.

JOYSSANCE

Since the 1960s, **Jouyssance** and its parent organization, the Foundation of the Neo-Renaissance, have been dedicated to performing both familiar and obscure repertoire of the 14th through mid 17th centuries. Although primarily a vocal ensemble, **Jouyssance** often features performances and accompaniments by period instruments.

MOSTLY MONTEVERDI: Heralded for his contributions to the early Baroque aesthetic, Claudio Monteverdi also produced some of the most exquisite music that is steadfastly late Renaissance in style. **Jouyssance** will present some of his early madrigals, plus his sacred music written deliberately in the Palestrina-like "stile antico." \$25 general admission; \$20 seniors, Friends of Music members, SCEMS members ; \$15 students
