ADVENT IS HERE!!!

TODAY we begin a new Church year with the first Sunday of Advent. Each Advent, we begin re-telling the story of Jesus' incarnation & birth, his life & teaching, his death & resurrection. It is our cycle of seasons and is very similar to the earth cycles of spring, summer, fall & winter. Like our earth, our Church year (or liturgical cycle) has representative colors and a variety of pieces which set each season apart from the others.

With Advent, we know that there will be four Sundays (not necessarily four weeks) until Christmas. This year, Christmas Day falls on a Wednesday, so the Week of Advent 4 is quite brief. This year we will have our tree-trimming party on the Saturday before Advent 4 (12/20).

In Advent, we hear of John the Baptist and of Mary, the mother of Our Lord. The liturgical color is blue which also reminds us of Mary. We light more candles on the Advent wreath each week to prepare us for Christ's coming — the Light of the World.

On Advent 2 (12/7), the Choir will present its annual Lessons & Carols of Advent which further present the prophecies that point to Jesus. In word, in color, in music — we get into a mind-set of waiting and watching for the Christ to be born — both in the world and also in each of us.

ROSE ??

As we reported in the last issue of the Quill a Rose chasuble and stole have been donated to the parish. We have ordered the matching pieces needed for the altar and lectern, but are not sure if they will arrive in time for the "Rose Sunday" in Advent (Dec. 14). However, after discussions, we have decided to mix the blue and rose sets that day if need be. So, stay tuned for the grand unveiling.
