OUTREACH AT ST. BEDE'S

Reaching out to help others in need is one of the oldest traditions of Christianity. We read about it in the *Acts of the Apostles*. In the Middle Ages, the position of "Almoner" was a person who distributed the "alms" collected at a worship service. Every Church budget I have ever seen — at every level of the Church (parish, diocese, national) always make provision for outreach (that is, helping someone or something that is part of the larger community in which it exists).

At St. Bede's, we have traditionally worked with the Neighborhood Youth Association; the food pantry at the St. Joseph Center; the lunch program feeding patients at the L. A. County/USC hospital HIV/AIDS unit; Daybreak (OPCC/homeless and mentally ill women); Hillside Home; and Turning Point (OPCC/ transitional housing).

We are looking at ideas for other programs which can both extend and focus our work. One of those is "Imagine L. A." which is mentioned below and from which we will have a presentation on April 19.

We offer to God "all that we are and all that we have" Please prayerfully consider how you can be involved in this part of Church life. Much of this offering focuses on what you can DO. In May, at our Annual St. Bede's Memorial Birthday celebration (May 25), we collect gifts for outreach.

IMAGINE L. A.

On Sunday, April 19, several representatives from **Imagine L. A.** will meet with us after the 10 a.m. service to tell about their group which is working to support families as they leave homelessness.
