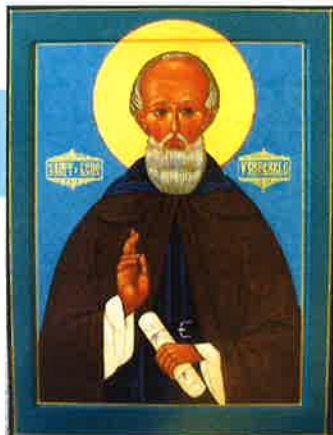

## ST. BEDE'S PATRONAL

St. Bede's will celebrate its annual commemoration of its Patronal Festival on Sunday, May 17, the Sunday prior to Memorial Day weekend (May 25 is the official



date that St. Bede is found in the Church's calendar). The Friends of Music will sponsor a Choral Evensong featuring the music of several modern composers, the most notable of which is Howard Helvey (pictured). Born 1968, resides in Cincinnati, Ohio, where he is active as a composer, arranger and pianist, and serves as organist and choirmaster of historic Calvary Episcopal Church. He is also co-founder and conductor of the Cincinnati Fusion Ensemble, a professional chamber choir. Nationally and internationally he is in frequent demand as a composer, conductor, speaker, and member of the Steinbach/Helvey Piano Duo. All are welcome at the evensong, which will be presented free of charge. A freewill offering will be taken to support the ministry of the Friends of Music.
