PENTECOST

Pentecost Sunday is one of the most ancient feasts of the Church, celebrated early enough to be mentioned in both Acts and 1st Corinthians. It is the 50th day after Easter (Pentecost), and it supplants the Jewish feast of Pentecost, which took place 50 days after the Passover.

Acts Ch. 2 tells the story — Jews from around the Diaspora were gathered in Jerusalem to celebrate. The Apostles were gathered in the upper room when suddenly they felt a great rush of wind along with the appearance of something like flames over their heads and their speaking in the variety of languages present in Jerusalem.

The promised Holy Spirit had arrived and the Apostles began to preach the Gospel in all of the languages. Over 3,000 people were converted and baptized that day.

Pentecost is often called "the birthday of the Church." On this day, with the descent of the Holy Spirit, Christ's mission is completed, and the New Covenant is inaugurated. We celebrate the day with red vestments and the extinguishing of the Paschal Candle after the final service.

This year, we will celebrate THE RENEWAL OF OUR Baptismal Vows at both services...WEAR RED!!!
