## CANON JIM'S THOUGHTS ON THE 78TH GENERAL CONVENTION

I have often said that the General Convention is one-third work, alumni meeting & state fair. This time, I will be a member of the Los Angeles deputation – the 3rd Alternate. I will be helping to track legislation in the Legislative Committee on Prayer Book, Liturgy & Music and serving on the “floor” when one of the deputies needs some time off. Furthermore, I will report on the General Convention in my sermon on Sunday, July 19. Later, I will set out a display of all of the materials from the various Episcopal & Anglican groups represented at the convention (even those with which I disagree).

The General Convention—Salt Lake City, UT, June 24–July 3— is the triennial meeting of The Episcopal Church. Modeled after the structure of the U. S. Congress, the House of Deputies (clergy & lay) and the House of Bishops will be presented with legislation covering the many issues facing Church and society in the 21st century. Some of the major issues include:

\*\*The TREC (Restructuring) Report — can we be leaner and trimmer in the way we work?

\*\*\*The Marriage Task Force Proposals: what is the institution of marriage in the 21st century? How do we respond pastorally & liturgically for all of our members?

\*\*\*How do the Church and the world meet to deal with issues such as human trafficking, poverty, inequality; economic divestment for ecological or political reasons?
