Thanks to the generosity of those who hosted and attended the venues and those who donated to and bought from the book cart in 2014-15, the Sisters of Bede were able to gift a total of **\$7,575** to the following:

St. Bede's 2nd Century Fund - \$3,700

The 2nd Century Fund is a designated account for maintaining the church building and grounds. Money donated to this account help cover unexpected costs that may come up throughout the year, and help support church improvement projects, such as re-roofing the building, putting anti-slip strips on the outside stairs, replacing windows, helping to erect the sign (maybe 2015 will be the year it happens!) etc. The fund is extremely important in making sure our spiritual home is regularly maintained and updated so we can come together and worship in a comfortable, beautiful environment.



Neighborhood Youth Association - \$2,475

Since its founding by the Episcopal Diocese of Los Angeles more than 100 years ago, Neighborhood Youth Association (NYA), has been improving the lives of at-risk young people and their families, providing services that accord with changing times and changing needs. NYA's Learning Center (for elementary, middle and high school students) is located just a few blocks down Grandview Blvd. from St. Bede's Church. St. Bede's provides two scholarships for NYA students entering or continuing in college. Friends of Music - \$500

The Friends of Music at St. Bede's are the primary source of financial support for the parish's renowned music program. Through contributions, concerts, and use of the building by outside musical groups, the Friends of Music raise money to support both their annual concert series and the ongoing music every Sunday morning and at other important services. Each year, the Friends of Music series presents three concerts (October, January, and the popular "Summer Cabaret" in June) and two Evensongs (one in Lent and one in Eastertide). In addition, it supports the music for the Advent Festival of Lessons and Carols, Christmas Eve, and the Easter Vigil. But most importantly, the Friends of Music support the regular Sunday morning music by providing money for two of the four paid section leaders in the St. Bede's Choir. Your contribution to the Friends of Music is an essential part of St. Bede's strong commitment to a ministry of music and hospitality.



Educate for Hope - \$350

Educate for Hope, a Hands in Healing initiative founded by Mary Bruno, is one of several partnerships between the Diocese of Los Angeles and the Diocese of Jerusalem, which share a companion relationship. Located between the cities of Nablus and Jenine in Palestine, Zababdeh is one of the few remaining predominantly Christian towns in the area. Educate for Hope helps educate children so that they may build lives for themselves, stay in their home country, and help stem the steady decline of the Christian population in the Holy Land. Educate for Hope now sponsors 56 students each school year. It costs about \$700 for each child to attend the school for one year.

Episcopal Relief & Dev. (Sanitation & Hygiene) - \$350

This organization enables communities to access adequate sanitation systems and protect against disease. Donations help to stop the spread of preventable diseases by going directly to helping communities access proper sanitation systems, learn about critical hygiene — and stay healthy. Our contributions help communities protect themselves and prevent the spread of disease by: supporting the construction and improvement of sanitary toilets and composting latrines to help reduce contamination, enabling the installation of hand-washing stations next to latrines in homes and schools, providing education on proper hand-washing and other hygiene practices, empowering local community health workers to train residents in safe garbage and waste disposal, ensuring the safety and security of land and water sources through integrated sanitation, hygiene and water programs.
