51ST ANNUAL MEETING COMING SOON!!

The 51st Annual Meeting will be held in Luther Hall following the 10 a.m. Holy Eucharist and a pot-luck luncheon on Sunday, Jan. 17. The Annual meeting is a time when reports covering the year past are made to the parish, the Vestry reports on the 2016 Budget which was passed by the Vestry in mid-December, and elections are held for open seats on the vestry & for St. Bede's representation to the Convention of the Diocese of Los Angeles.

The Nominating Committee of the Vestry will present a roster of candidates: For Vestry: 5 candidates—2 yr. terms (Elizabeth Coombs, James Davis and Canon Annette Graw are retiring from the vestry). The Vestry meets on the 4th Monday each month and for a winter planning retreat on February 20, 2016. Members serve on at least one of the three main committees: Finance & Facilities, Outreach, and Program.

For Diocesan Convention Delegate and Alternate (1 delegate & 2 alternates): These people represent the parish at the Annual Convention of the Diocese (12/2-3, 2016) and at any meetings of the Deanery, as scheduled.
