THE OUTREACH AND INREACH OF FOOD

Jesus and his disciples ate together. Jesus joined in meals at various times in the Gospels — often as a way to become involved in conversations or a teaching situation. At other times, Jesus used the setting of a meal to indicate his welcome of those who were often unwelcome and marginalized. Food is very important!

If that is true, then we here at St. Bede's must be very faithful as we have many occasions at which food is shared, served, created, etc. We have fellowship dinners, coffee hours, pot-luck events, and meals which we serve as a form of Christian outreach. I want to talk briefly about three of those meals.

First, receptions for major events (funerals, marriages, baptisms, etc.). Due to issues of food preparation and its service to many from outside the congregation, these events will from now on either be catered by those involved or professional caterers. Guilds and parishioners may help with the use of the kitchen or the hall, but will not be asked to do the catering.

Christian outreach events related to food have been curtailed. We are still serving dinners for the OPCC periodically. The luncheon program to the HIV/AIDS Clinic at the County Hospital has ended due to patients becoming ill from food (thankfully, not that was prepared by us).

Coffee hours after the 8 & 10 a.m. Sunday services are a major variable. Everyone seems to like to attend, but fewer and fewer like to host. What to do. We think that these times of refreshment are great for the community, but we need to lessen both the amount of work and the expense.

Smaller events are the St. John's & SoB pot-lucks and the various SoB venue events. They seem to be running smoothly and are not affected. How we gather at the table is important .. And we have been doing it since Jesus' time.
