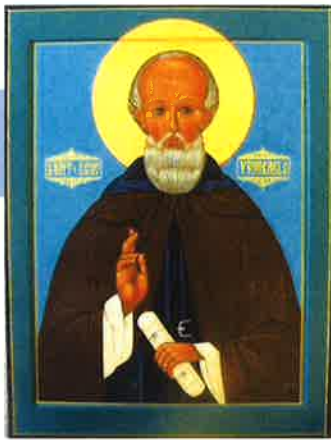

ANNUAL MEETING
REFLECTION

At the Annual Meeting, we realized that we will have to do more with less. The Vestry cut several items from the 2017 budget: the 2nd part of Frank's raise, the funding for the Rector's sabbatical and lowering the pledge to the Diocese from 12% (the asking) to 8%. That is a total of just under \$30,000. Pledged income for 2017 is \$3,000 less than 2016. We received \$18,757 in "new" money, but lost \$20,560 due to movement or death. That hurts a small congregation. Obviously, we will reconsider the budget as the year goes on and we receive new pledges and other unexpected moneys. Worry about the budget also slowed the process of looking at our SB50 goals to improve the "plant." JN+

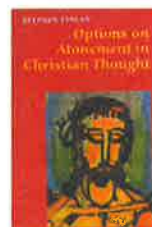
LENT STUDY PREPARATION
