I have noted before that Episcopalians call themselves an “Easter People.” While we love Advent/Christmas and all the “stuff” that goes with it, we are named, marked and sent because of our relationship with the Risen Christ. “Alleluia” is our cry and “Christian” is our name.

This is so important, the Church gives it a season, not simply a day. We have 50 days in which to “live and move and have our being” as Easter People. We didn’t take that mantle off when we returned to our homes on Easter Day. As part of our inspiration on Sundays, we hear the witness of the early Church from Acts. The Gospels present us reports of resurrection appearances of Jesus and also his teachings from John’s Gospel that guided the early Church. The readings from 1 Peter are from the end of the 1st Century. One commentator notes, “First Peter focuses on the importance of believers bearing up under unjust suffering yet continuing to live well.”

We will focus on the 1st Epistle of Peter on Sunday, April 23 when we will premiere “The Lessons & Carols of the Early Church”, one of seven services I have composed to present the various themes of Eastertide in word and hymnody.

Of special note during May is the 7th annual **Womens’ Retreat**. This year, the May 20th event will again be held at the Mary & Joseph Retreat Center in Palos Verdes, CA (5300 Crest Rd.); the retreat leader will be the Rev. Julie Morris. (right) Please sign up in the narthex by May 13.
